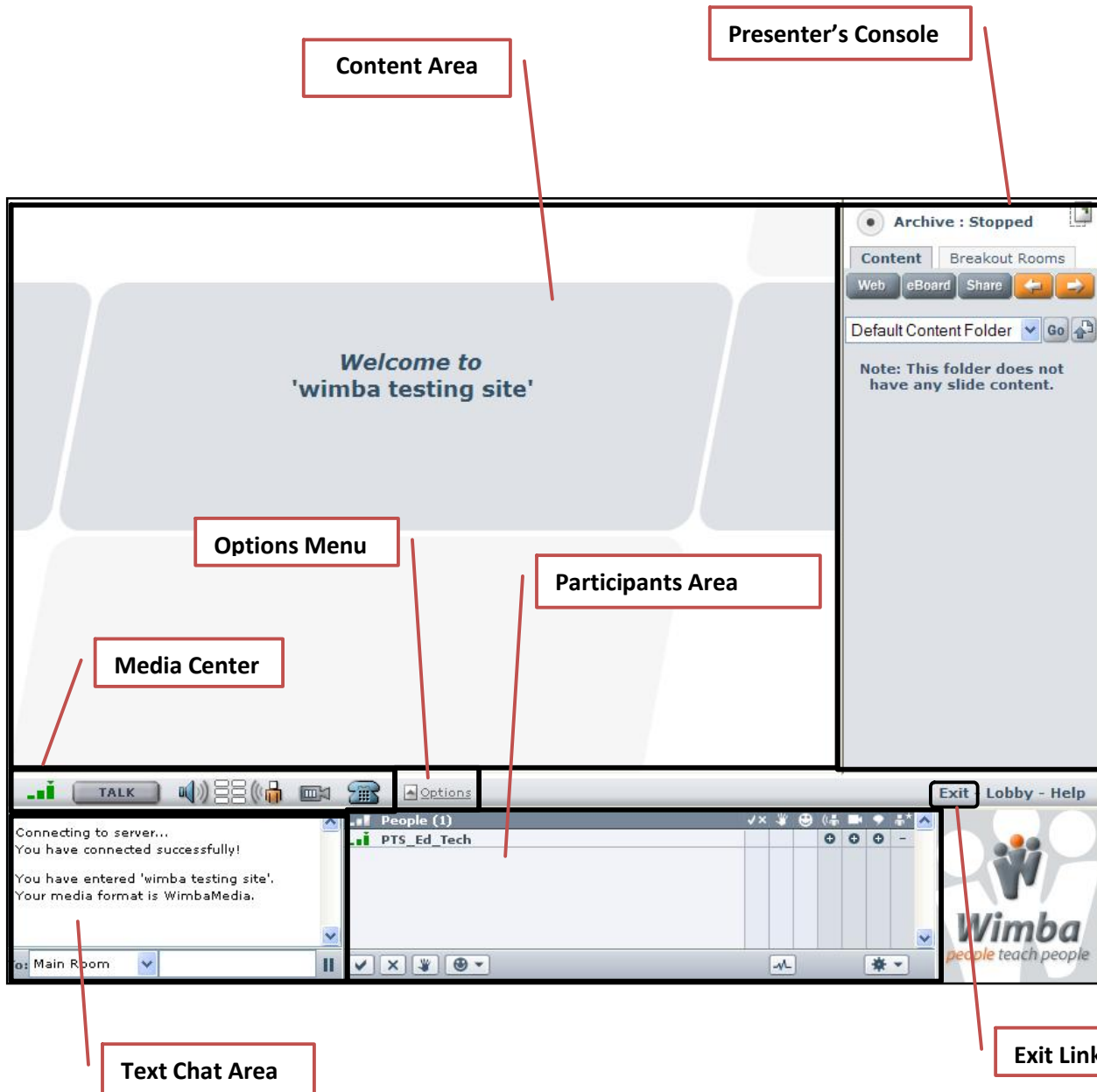


Overview of Wimba Room Interface

Wimba Classroom is a synchronous (live) conferencing tool integrated with our Blackboard system. It provides audio, video, text chat, and application sharing tools that allow for live interactions.

Tip: To ensure that all Wimba room tools load properly, run the setup wizard before your Wimba session, at least the first time you use Wimba on a specific computer. (Check the EU Blackboard Support site for instructions).

Content Area: Displays websites, documents, images, PowerPoint presentations, etc.

Presenter's Console: Provides access to features needed for a live presentation such as displaying content, archiving and breakout rooms.

Chat Text Area: Allows for private and public text-based communication with and among participants.

Media Center: Appears above the text tool and provides audio and video tools.

Participant Area: Lists all presenters and participants. It also provides emoticons that participants can use to communicate, e.g. Yes, No, Away, etc.

Options Menu: Provides access to additional media settings. Settings are available only during the current session of Wimba and would need to be selected upon re-entry.
