


EU GRADS CONTINUE TO DO WELL AFTER GRADUATION: FROM THE SURVEY OF THE MOST RECENT COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES (CAS) GRADUATING CLASS, A TOTAL OF 93% OF THE RESPONDENTS ARE WORKING, INVOLVED IN POST-GRADUATE EDUCATION, OR SERVING IN FULL TIME VOLUNTEER WORK WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF GRADUATION. *





*55% of the Class of 2013 participated in this survey (169 of 309 graduates).

EMPLOYMENT

77% of the CAS Class of 2013 survey respondents reported employment as their primary activity following graduation. 80% of those employed are working in full-time positions. The majority of those employed are working in the private sector (45%), although many are also working in the nonprofit arena (37%).







75% of employed graduate respondents reported that their job was directly related or somewhat related to their major.




INTERNSHIPS & PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

76% of the CAS Class of 2013 survey respondents reported participating in an internship/student teaching/practical experience while enrolled at Eastern. 79% of those received academic credit for those experiences. 71% of respondents completed experiences the summer before senior year or during their senior year.










86% of survey respondents believe their internship/practical experiences were helpful or somewhat helpful in securing employment.
