

Exchange Student Application Instructions

Carefully read all instructions on this document, as they apply to both the exchange student application and the process of enrolling at Eastern University.

Application

Please complete the following application, and return it along with your completed housing contract (for those residing on campus) and health forms (for all students), a transcript from your host institution and a \$150 prepayment of your semester fees to the address at the bottom of the application. Students wishing to study at Eastern University for our fall (August - December) semester must submit their documents to Eastern by March15. Students wishing to study in our spring semester (January - May) must do so by October15.

After submitting these documents, students will be notified of their user-name and passwords for both their Eastern University email account, as well as their my.eastern.edu page. Instructions on how to access this page will be included in the mailing. You will be able to view your class schedule and bill through this student portal.

Housing and Meal Plans

Housing will be assigned to Exchange students after their Housing Contract is received by the Admissions Office and provided to the Housing Office. Students can make specific housing requests on the Housing Contract, however, Eastern University cannot guarantee that the requests will be able to be honored.

There is a variety of meal plan options available to Eastern students. Each plan is assigned the same price. You will be assigned to the Unlimited Meal Plan unless you request a different plan to the Housing Office. Such requests need to be made at least 20 days prior to the start of the semester, and can be made from your Eastern University email account. Send all requests to housing@eastern.edu.

Class Registration

Class registrations will be processed by the Registrar's Office according to the classes approved for exchange students and course availability. The Registrar will email your registration to you when it is completed.

Costs and Fees

Exchange students are required to pay room, board and health insurance costs to Eastern University. Information on all costs can be found here: <u>www.eastern.edu/sa</u>. Please note: room costs vary depending on the style of room to which you are assigned. We cannot guarantee the standard room rate.

Student bills will be accessible through their <u>my.eastern.edu</u> page at least one month prior to the start of the semester. All bills must be paid in full prior to the student's arrival to campus (August 15 for fall semesters, December 15 for spring semesters.) Payment plans are not permitted for exchange students.

Health Insurance

All Eastern students are required to have health insurance during their time at Eastern. International students are required to purchase coverage through Eastern's health insurance plan, and this cost will be automatically added to your bill. Why a J-Visa?

Exchange students at Eastern study under the terms of a J-Visa. This is different from a traditional student visa (an F-Visa), however, it is appropriate for students studying under the terms of an existing exchange relationship between two institutions.
