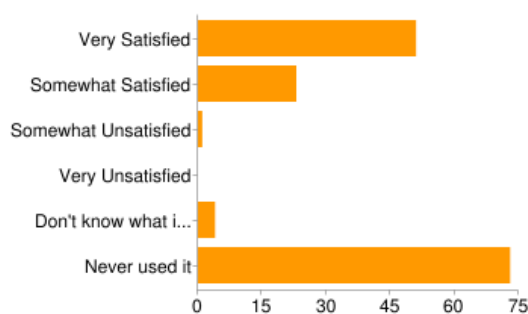

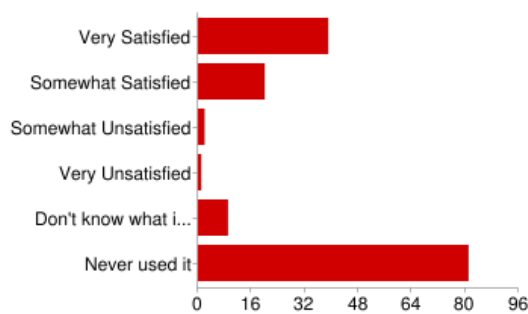

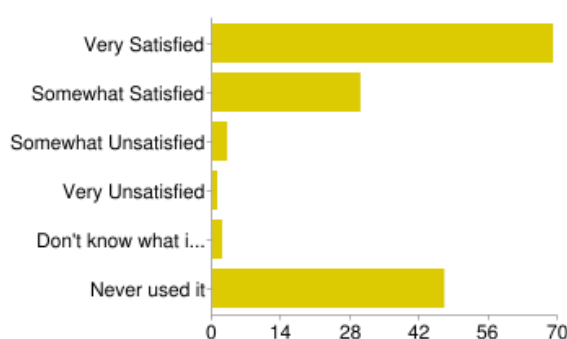

**RAPID ILL (Interlibrary loan articles) [Please rate the following resources. How well do they satisfy your information needs?]**



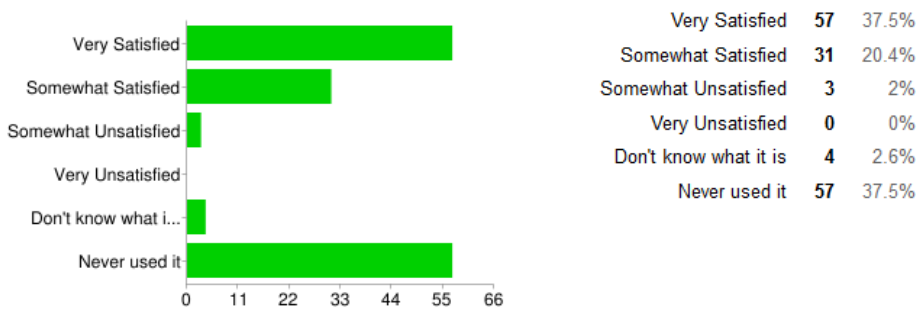

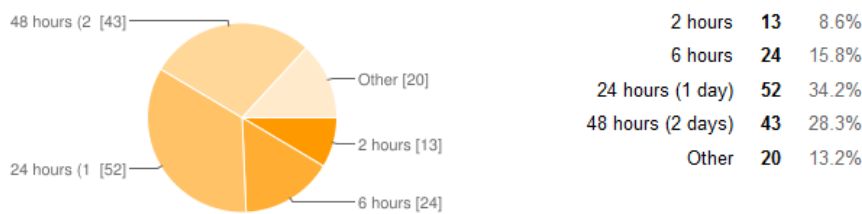

The ILL request details are returned with the articles and book chapters so are obviously available for an automated email confirmation. The submission confirmation with the request details would make it much easier to monitor the status of ILL requests.</p> <p>2 - It would help to have ILL book check out and returns coordinated with local university libraries for distance learners. For instances, I live near Alvernia University, Reading, PA and would like to pick up and drop off ILL book loans via my Eastern enrollment through them (or another college/university). Alternatively, EU might offer to ship EU or ILL book requests to students and accept shipped returns. Distance learners cannot take advantage of Eastern's library (full book) or ILL (full book) resources if check out and returns must occur at a EU location so we are losing some of the value of our enrollment.</p> <p>3 - Ongoing research database access for doctoral graduates who are not going pursuing a career in academia would be fantastic. Practitioners not affiliated with a college or university do not have access to research article databases which would be very beneficial for professional development.</p>	Please consider offering emergency research database support for distance doctoral learners. We tend to be working adults and take advantage of holidays to work on assignments, comprehensive exams, and dissertations. It would be very helpful to have an emergency holiday contact when there are problems with remote database access.
