

The decision to withdraw from a course is made in consultation with the student's academic advisor. The completed form must be submitted to the Registrar within 10 weeks of the session start date (equivalent period for summer sessions).

Attention Financial Aid Recipients: Eligibility for renewal of financial aid is based upon satisfactory academic progress at the end of the current year. Undergraduate students anticipating grants, student loans, or College Work Study for the next academic year must earn at least 24 credits in the current year. Students in the third or fourth years of aid must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0. Similar requirements apply to graduate students. Consult the current catalog or the Financial Aid Directory for complete regulations.
