Dr. Gordon A. Zook, PhD '15



Dr. Gordon Zook currently serves as the Chief Executive Officer of Ten Thousand Villages, a fair trade retailer and wholesaler based in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. Previously, Dr. Zook was the India Co-Country Director for the Mennonite Central Committee (MCC) in Kolkata, India. He also has international leadership experience with MCC in Bangladesh and in Haiti. In addition to his international work, he has worked in general management with a Lancaster-based construction firm and as an agricultural loan officer with Farm Credit Service.

Dr. Zook received a Bachelor of Science degree from Michigan State University and a Master of Science from Cornell University, both in Agricultural Economics. He earned his

PhD in Organizational Leadership from Eastern University where his dissertation focused on how leadership teams assess and impact the effectiveness of their organizations. He has found opportunities to apply learnings from his research to his work with Ten Thousand Villages and MCC.

As a global maker-to-market movement, Ten Thousand Villages connects artisans in developing countries with conscious shoppers in the U.S. by offering ethically sourced gifts, homewares, and fashion accessories crafted by hand. Every product generates sustainable income — and impact — for 20,000 makers in 30 countries who earn a fair, living wage in safe working conditions. Partnering with people often excluded from the marketplace, particularly women, Ten Thousand Villages shares the craft, culture, and stories of makers through a network of over 50 branded stores and 300-plus retail partners, as well as an e-commerce shop. As a pioneer of fair trade, Ten Thousand Villages does business differently: putting people and planet first — since 1946.

Dr. Zook and his wife Carol have been married for 38 years. They are the proud parents of four young adult children: three sons and one daughter.

SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT

In order to recognize the superior scholastic achievement of a student during his/her academic course, the University awards bachelor's degrees with honors. Transfer students are eligible for these honors if they have completed at least 60 semester hours of Eastern University credit.

Summa cum laude: cumulative grade-point average of 3.90 or better

Magna cum laude: cumulative grade-point average of 3.75 to 3.899

Cum laude: cumulative grade-point average of 3.50 to 3.749

With Distinction: the designation for graduating students with cumulative grade-point averages of 3.8 or better and 39-59 credits earned at Eastern University.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The medieval scholar wore a clerical robe so all would know his station in society. The clerical robe was appropriate since all students were expected to become part of the clergy. Distinctions have always been made among the academic grades. Thus, the robe of the doctor is more elaborate than that of the master and the master is different than the undergraduate.

Academic regalia may consist of three parts—the gown, the hood and the cap. There is considerable variation in European universities. In 1893, a system was adopted in the United States so that one could tell at a glance the university where the degree was earned, the field of study in which the degree was earned, and the level of the earned degree.

Most robes are black; although, occasionally a university may adopt a robe of another color such as Harvard in adopting the crimson as its own. Doctoral robes are longer, fuller and more richly trimmed with bands of velvet down the front and on the sleeves. These can be black or symbolize a field of study. The master's gown has sleeves usually cut above the elbow and the bachelor's gown is a simple pleated robe.

The cap of most American universities is usually the stiff, square black traditional mortar board with a black tassel. The doctoral cap may have a gold tassel with the tassel worn on the left. Many European universities favor the soft beret-type cap. A few American institutions use this cap as well.

The hood is the most interesting and colorful part of the regalia. The largest hood is the doctor's. The colors of the hood's lining, arranged in chevrons, symbolize the colors of the college or university which granted the degree. Thus, Eastern University of St. Davids, PA has chevrons of maroon and white. The velvet trim, visible at the neck, indicates the field of study in which the degree was earned. Some frequently seen hood colors and the fields of study from Eastern University are as follows:
