A MESSAGE FROM THE DEAN



For senior Noah Westbrook, his internship has been all about critical thinking and communication. While classroom learning prepared him for the challenge, being on-the-job served to sharpen his skills. We had the opportunity to ask Noah about his real-world experiences.

Q. What are the two most important skills you gained during your internship?

A. I think No. 1 would be efficient problem-solving in real time. Enterprise Holdings is a quick-paced environment that involves fast resolutions to immediate problems. Learning how to respond in such a fast-moving office has improved my ability to think critically and make smart business decisions in an instant. I have visibly noticed that this skill has allowed me to remain calm and think clearly during pressure situations.

The other important skill I honed was my ability to communicate. Working at Enterprise has also taught me the significance of a strong talk path when working with a customer. Before this internship, I had little experience with sales. During this experience, I have come to understand how to ask the right questions when having a conversation with a customer, so that I am better able to serve their needs while also explaining to them the benefits of the products we offer. From this, the customer is more informed and has a better overall experience with our business.
