I. FORM

To transition to a Bachelor's degree program within Eastern University, please complete the following form, and return it to the address at the bottom of the application.

II. CLASS REGISTRATION

Class registration will be completed when all Esperanza Transition students complete the required paperwork for enrollment in a Bachelor's degree program with the appropriate Admissions Office and register for classes, regardless of their intended program of study. Coursework at Esperanza must be completed before new registrations can be processed.

III. COSTS AND FEES

Students are required to pay the appropriate tuition rates for their degree program. Additionally, students are eligible to take advantage of scholarship and other financial aid opportunities available within their degree program (if applicable). Applicants should also file the FAFSA as quickly as possible after October 1st of the fall semester preceding their enrollment. Students must file by May 1 in order to qualify for any PA state assistance.

Students interested in a degree program in Eastern's traditional undergraduate options have the option of residing on campus and taking part in the campus meal plan.

Student bills will be accessible through their Web Advisor page at least one month prior to the start of the semester. All bills must be paid in full prior to the start of the program. Payment plans are available.

IV. HEALTH INSURANCE

All traditional undergraduate Eastern students are required to have health insurance during their time at Eastern. This includes students in the BSW program at Esperanza College. Students are offered coverage through Eastern's health insurance plan, and this cost will be automatically added to their bill. Students can opt out of this coverage if they have their own insurance plan by completing the waiver request found at www.firststudent.com.
