#### 2019-2020 FAFSA Now Available!

The 2019-2020 FAFSA became available to file on October 1, 2018 at www.FAFSA.ed.gov. You will need to file your 2019-2020 FAFSA using the prior-prior year's tax information—your (and your parent's) 2017 taxes. We strongly recommend that you use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on your 2019-2020 FAFSA to avoid additional paperwork. Make sure that your household size and number in college reflects the 2019-2020 academic year.

### **December 2018 Graduation**

December is just around the corner and for those of you who will be graduating, it cannot get here fast enough. As you prepare yourselves for the last several weeks of classes, don't forget some very important items:

- 1) Check with the Student Accounts Office to make sure you do not owe any money on your bill - my.Eastern.edu, 610-341-5831, or student.accounts@eastern.edu.
- 2) Check with the Registrar's Office to make sure your address is up-to-date to ensure timely delivery of your diploma.

- 3) If you are/were a Direct Loan recipient at any point during your education, make sure to complete your Federal Direct Loan Exit Counseling online at www.StudentLoans.gov.
- 4) If you were a Perkins Loan recipient, you will receive instructions on how to complete your online Perkins Loan Exit Interview from ECSI via US Mail.
- 5) Check out the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) for a complete list of your Federal Loanswww.NSLDS.ed.gov.
- 6) Stay in contact with your
