- To access your 2018-2019 Financial Aid and Student Accounts (billing) Information:
- \Rightarrow Go to my.Eastern.edu
- \Rightarrow Click on the "Sign-in to your My.Eastern" picture
- \Rightarrow Log in with your EU username and password
- \Rightarrow Select the Financial Aid link then click on the "Financial Aid Checklist" link
 - To view needed documents, click on the Required Documents tab.
 - To accept or decline your financial aid, go to the My Awards tab. You will also be prompted on your Home tab to review and electronically sign your Award Letter.
 Once you accept or decline an award online, if you later choose to change your decision, email us at <u>finaid@eastern.edu</u>. Check out our <u>helpful guide</u>.
 - A Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling must be completed by new students at www.StudentLoans.gov in order for Federal Direct Loan funds to be applied to your bill.
