2019-2020 Aid Updates

The 2019-2020 Award Letters for Returning Students are now available online at my.Eastern.edu. Award Letters for new students who are starting in Summer or Fall 2019 were mailed home before the Winter Break. On my.Eastern.edu, make sure to review your awards in their entirety as well as the Financial Aid Checklist and Required Documents.

- If you want to borrow the 2019-20 Direct Loans that are on your award letter, you must accept the loans online at my.Eastern.edu under the My Awards tab.
- If this is your first time borrowing Direct Loans, you will also need to complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN– Unsubsidized/Subsidized) and Entrance Counseling (EC) online at <https://studentloans.gov>.
- If you haven't filed a 2019-2020 FAFSA yet and are a PA Resident, make sure you do so by **May 1, 2019**.

Spring 2019 Add/Drop

Spring 2019 and Spring I 2019 courses will begin the week of January 14. Traditional undergraduate and graduate students on a semester-long schedule can add until January 22 and drop courses until January 29. Non-traditional students on the 7-week calendar can add and drop courses until January 22. Enrollment Verifications

Students can now produce an enrollment verification document right from myEastern. Once logged in, select “Academic Plan- Registration” from the blue Student menu, then “Enrollment Verification”. This request will prompt your to reenter your log in information. The verification maybe downloaded as a pdf document or saved as a file to your hard drive.

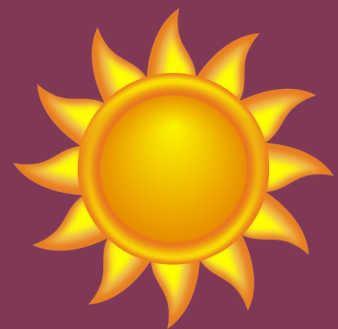
2018 1098T Tax Forms
