If you will be enrolled in Summer 2021, Fall 2021, and/or Spring 2022, make sure to file your 21-22 FAFSA today at StudentAid.gov. Be sure to use your 2019 tax information. PA Residents must file by MAY 1 in order to be considered for a PA State Grant.



Traditional Undergraduate Return to Campus

Back in November, two emails were sent out to students regarding important information for the Spring 2021 semester. Please check your EU email account for a November 6th email from President Matthews and a November 18th email from the Housing Office. These emails discuss topics such as the updated COVID Testing Fee, COVID Testing dates, when students will be notified on returning to campus and much more. Please make sure to review those emails and any future emails carefully.

Last Day to Drop for Spring 2021

Tuesday, February 2nd is the last day to drop a course for the Spring 2021 semester. The last day to drop for the Spring I 2020 term is Tuesday, January 19th. The last day to withdraw from the Spring I 2021 term is Friday, February 5th. Not attending a course does NOT drop you from a course— you must notify the Registrar's Office via the appropriate form that you want to drop or withdraw from a course. We recommend that you check with your Advisor, Student Accounts, and Financial Aid to understand the impact of a drop or withdrawal on your academic and financial record.

Late Payment Fee

Spring 1 2021 bills are due January 11th. Spring 2021 bills are due January 19th. If you do not have aid to cover your charges OR are not set up on a payment plan OR have not already paid your balance in full, you are at risk of being assessed a LATE FEE. Make sure to check your my.Eastern.edu account TODAY to see if you have an outstanding balance. It's also important to monitor your EU email account as notifications about bills due and late fees will be sent to your EU email account from Student Accounts.
