Last Day to Drop for Spring 2022

Tuesday, January 25th is the last day to <u>drop</u> a course for the Spring 2022 semester. The last day to drop for the Spring I 2022 term is Tuesday, January 18th. The last day to <u>withdraw</u> from the Spring I 2022 term is Friday, February 4th. Not attending a course does NOT drop you from a course– you must notify the Registrar's Office via the appropriate form that you want to drop or withdraw from a course. We recommend that you check with your Advisor, Student Accounts, and Financial Aid to understand the impact of a drop or withdrawal on your academic and financial record. Don't forget to Like our

Late Payment Fee

Spring I 2022 and Spring 2022 bills are due January 10th. If you do not have aid to cover your charges OR are not set up on a payment plan OR have not already paid your balance in full, you are at risk of being assessed a LATE FEE. Make sure to check your my.Eastern.edu account TODAY to see if you have an outstanding balance. It's also important to monitor your EU email account as notifications about bills due and late fees will be sent to your EU email account from Student Accounts.

- Then click SAVE.
