## File Your 2022-2023 FAFSA

The Financial Aid Office is gearing up to start putting together 2022-23 Financial Aid Packages and will start issuing them to students via my.Eastern.edu in December 2021. If you will be enrolled in Summer 2022, Fall 2022, and/or Spring 2023, we strongly encourage you to file the 22-23 FAFSA as soon as possible at [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov). You will need to use your 2020 tax information for the 22-23 FAFSA.



If any financial aid paperwork is needed, we will email you and post the information to your myEastern account. The [22-23 forms](#) (Church Matching Grant, Ministerial Discount Form, EU Family Grant Form) are now posted online and can be submitted to our office as soon as you have them completed. Please make sure to continue to check your EU email account and myEastern account over the Thanksgiving and Winter breaks.
