Summer 2019 & Fall 2019 Registration

On February 22, the University Registrar emailed all students, faculty, and staff with information regarding Summer and Fall registration. Please make sure to review the email carefully and in its entirety to ensure you don't miss any important information. Students should connect with their Advisor to plan courses. All Undergraduate and Palmer students will need advisor approval of their planned courses before they can register. 

Intent to Graduate

Students who plan to complete their degree within the next year should submit an “Intent to Graduate” Form to the Office of the Registrar. Students who are pursuing a certification only, excluding CAGS, are not required to submit this form. You can pick up the form in the Registrar’s Office or [online](#).

The Housing Deposit is due March 15th and will be assessed to your Student Account bill next week!



Graduation Fee

The graduation fee is generated by the student submitting the Intent to Graduate Form and the student meeting all graduation requirements. All students receiving a degree from Eastern University are assessed the graduation fee, which is listed on the schedule of student charges (tuition and fees) on the Student Accounts webpage. The graduation fee covers costs for professional services, diploma printing, postage and life-long degree confirmation service for graduated students, as well as costs related to commencement activities. Every graduate’s name is printed in the commencement program and academic regalia is provided at no additional charge, even if the graduate chooses not to participate in a ceremony.
