On-Campus Summer Employment

If you completed a Summer Employment Application online and have fulfilled all the necessary requirements, notification was emailed to your Eastern email account. If you are still needing to submit documentation, please do so as soon as possible so a determination can be made.

Summer 2019 is part of the 2019-2020 academic year and will require a new work contract. **No work may begin without a new work contract being completed and turned into Human Resources in HHC.** Don't forget to fill out your appropriate time card online at my.Eastern.edu.

FastPass & Financial Aid

If you are participating in FastPass or FastPass Lite during Summer 2019, please read the following information carefully.

All students enrolled for summer classes will receive a bill from Student Accounts. If you are eligible for FastPass, you will receive a FastPass Award on your Financial Aid package and it will also appear on your Summer bill(s). If you do not see a FastPass Award on your bill, please reach out to our office at finaid@eastern.edu, 610-225-5102, or stop by the Financial Aid Office for assistance.

Summer & Fall Registration

Graduation

Commencement for Eastern University students will be held on Saturday, May 11. Commencement for Palmer Theological Seminary students will be held on Thursday, May 16. Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

To determine a student's continued eligibility for financial aid, we review:

- ◇ Completion of at least 67% of All Credits Attempted
- ◇ Specified Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)
- ◇ Completion of degree requirements is 150% of the published program length

The Financial Aid Office will notify students via their EU email account who fail to meet these requirements when information on academic progress is available at the end of their academic year. You should also check your SAP status on the Financial Aid link of my.Eastern.edu. Students who fail to meet these requirements will not be considered for financial aid until all standards have been achieved. A student who has not made SAP may submit the SAP Appeal Form (included with notification) to Financial Aid if they feel that there were extenuating circumstances that contributed to not making progress.

2019-20 aid will not disburse to your Student Account until SAP can be verified from 18-19 grades. SAP cannot be checked if you have any incomplete or unrecorded grades. For more details, please review our full [SAP Policy](#) online.

Taking Courses Elsewhere Over the Summer

A current student must get permission before taking courses at another institution if they wish to transfer them back into Eastern. Getting approval lets you ensure that the credits and grades earned will be calculated into your Eastern GPA, and that the courses will satisfy desired requirements or electives.
