Health Insurance Waiver Deadline!

The **2019-2020 student health insurance waiver/enrollment application** is available until **September 10, 2019** at: <https://www.gallagherstudent.com/>

- 1) Login using your Eastern University email address as your username and your temporary password is your Student ID Number. Please add "0"s at the beginning to make it a 9-digit number (i.e. 000123456).
- 2) Instructions to reset your password will be sent to your Eastern University email address.

If you do not waive the insurance by the deadline, you will be responsible for paying that fee. If you need assistance, please contact Student Accounts at student.accounts@eastern.edu, 610-341-5831, or stop by the HUB.

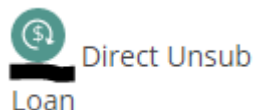
Pell Grant & Loan Disbursement Dates

Your Pell Grant and Federal Loan disbursement dates can be found on the Account Summary of your bill.

1. Scroll down to the Financial Aid section

Refund Checks

Once your aid has been applied/disbursed to your bill, any credit on your account will be refunded to you within 10 business days via a paper check mailed to your home address. You can sign up for e-Refund, which will deposit the money into the bank account of your choosing. Follow the instructions below to sign up:

1. Log in to my.Eastern.edu
2. Click Self-Service menu
3. Click Student Accounts
4. Select Bank Information

Fall Registration Changes

Tuesday, September 3 is the last day to add Fall 2019 semester courses, and the last day to add and drop Fall block 1 accelerated courses. Monday, September 9 is the last day to drop Fall 2019 courses. Monday, October 28 is the last day to add or drop Fall 2 accelerated courses. If you need assistance with making changes to you registration, please contact the Registrar's Office at registrar@eastern.edu, 610-341-5853, or stop by Mall Cottage.

Enrollment Verification

The Registrar's Office verifies student enrollment to federal lending agencies through the National Student Loan Data System. Students are also welcome to access and share their own enrollment verification report with anyone. First log into myEastern, next click on Academic Plan-Registration, then Enrollment Verification. This will prompt you to re-enter your Eastern log in information. Your enrollment verification may then be downloaded as a PDF.
