ABOUT THE SURVEY

TRADITIONAL UNDERGRADUATE BACCALAUREATE COLLEGES: CLASS OF 2025 FIRST DESTINATION SURVEY

The First Destination Survey provides an overview regarding the status of Eastern University Traditional Undergraduate Baccalaureate (TUB) alumni within six to nine months of graduation. For the purposes of this survey, "Class of 2025" is defined as a TUB student who graduated in August 2024, December 2024, or May 2025. The Center for Career Development gathered statistics using the professional guidelines set forth by NACE (National Association for Colleges and Employers). The First Destination Survey, created using Qualtrics and shaped by NACE guidelines, was distributed electronically to TUB alumni. Faculty members were contacted via email in early 2026 about graduates whose status remained unknown. Additionally, information on non-responders was retrieved from updated professional profiles on social media sites (primarily LinkedIn), my.eastern, and employer web pages.

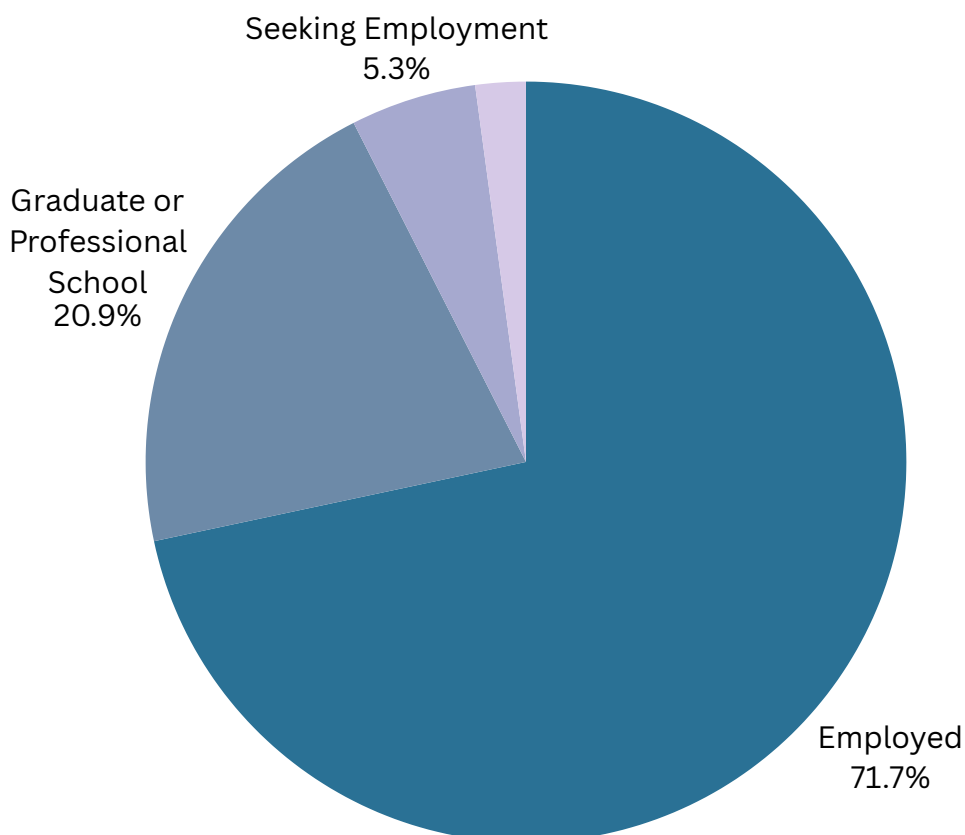
Through this extensive process, we obtained an 83% knowledge rate (194 responses) of the Class of 2025. "Knowledge rate" as defined by NACE is the "percent of graduates for which an institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities." 65% is the NACE industry benchmark, which the Center for Career Development exceeded. Our intention is to provide a summary of first destination highlights, as well as a specific breakdown by TUB Colleges for the Class of 2025.

GENERAL SUMMARY

94.7% of the Class of 2025 survey respondents are employed, involved in post-graduate education, or serving in full-time volunteer work within 6-9 months of graduation.

Graduates of the Class of 2025 were asked to identify their **primary activity** after graduation. 71.7% are employed, 20.9% are in graduate or professional school, 5.3% are seeking employment, 2.1% are participating in a volunteer or service program.

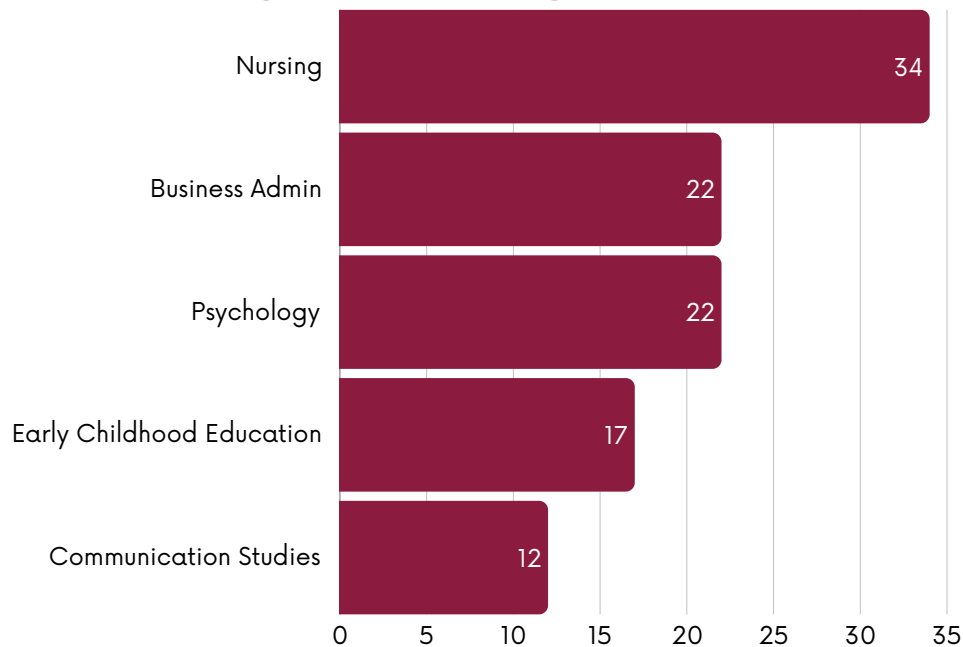

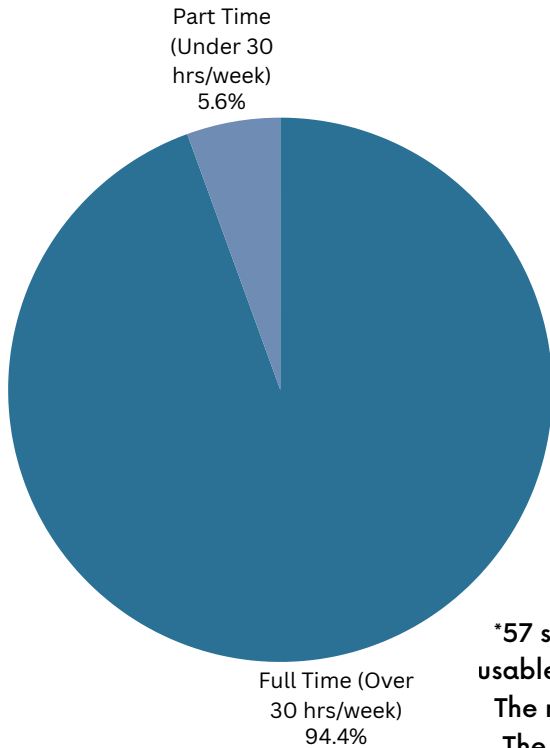
Count of Top Majors Among the EU Class of 2025



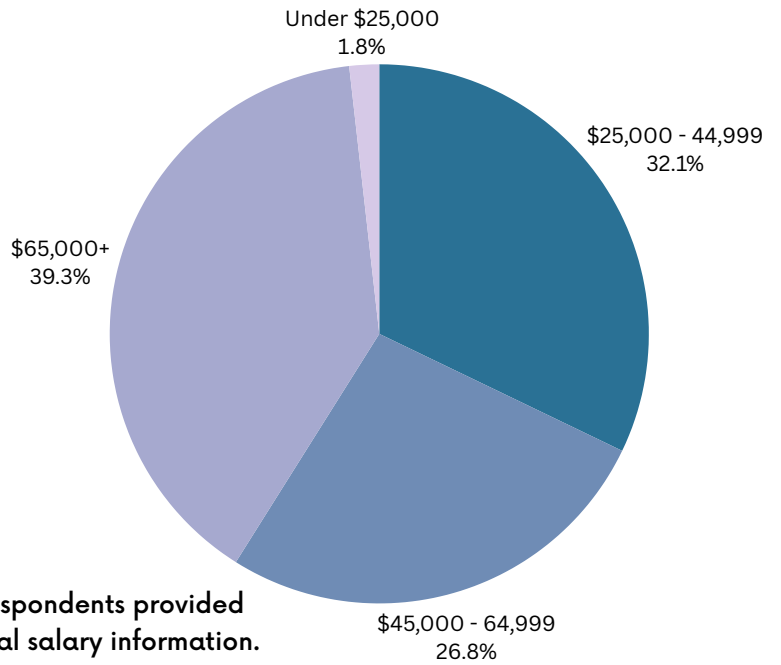
Employment:

71.6% of the Class of 2025 survey respondents reported employment as their primary activity following graduation. 94.4% of those employed are working in full-time positions. 97.1% of employed graduates indicate their current job is related or somewhat related to their major. 86.2% of employed graduates are very satisfied or satisfied with their current employment.

Types of Employment

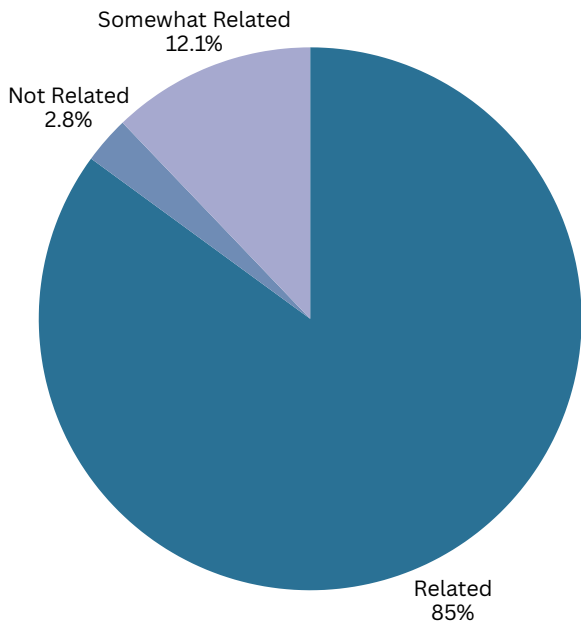

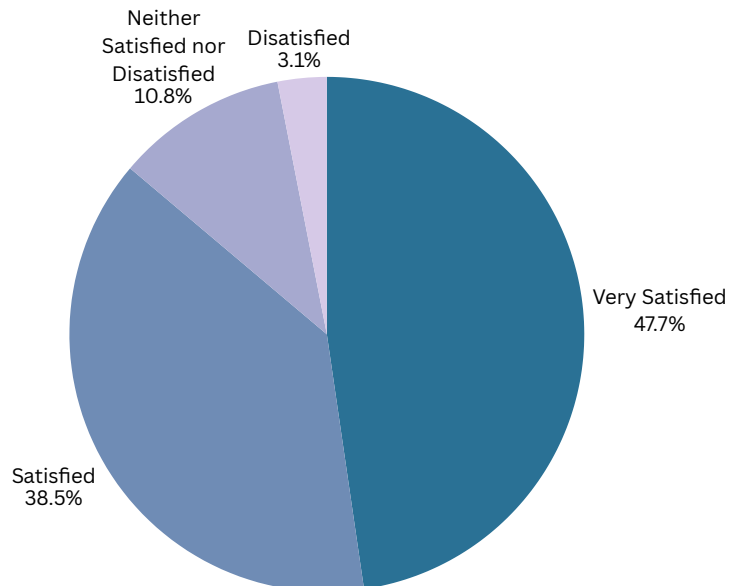

Satisfaction with Current Employment

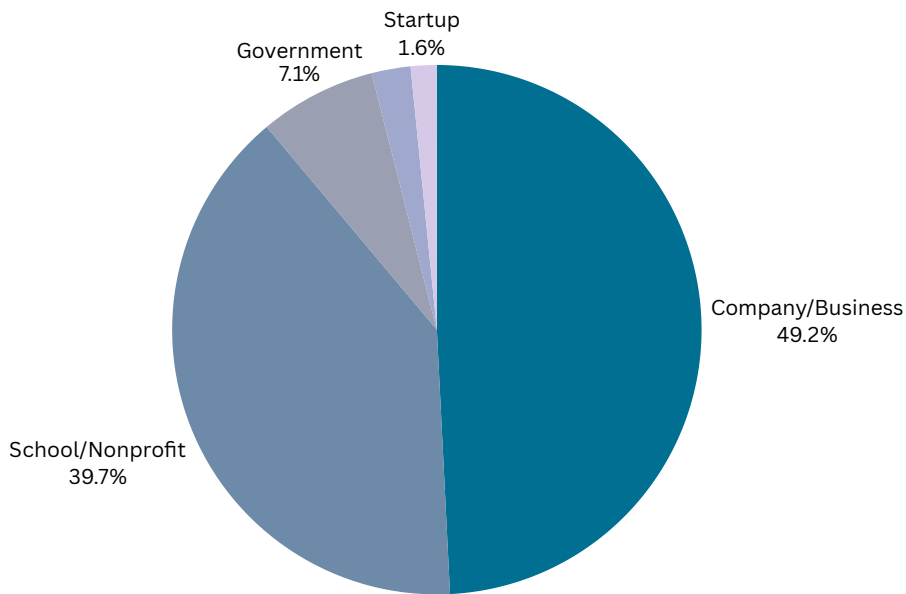

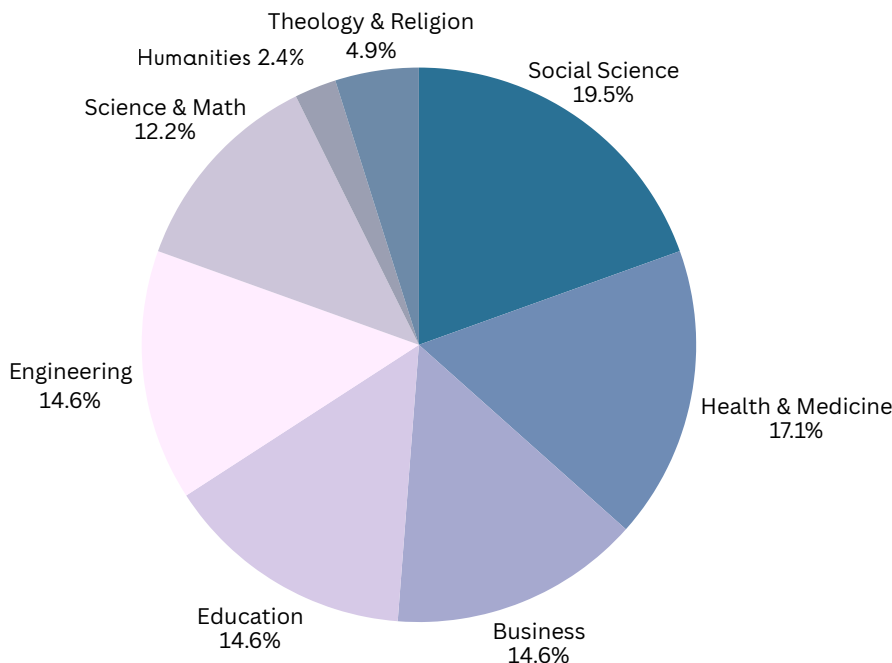

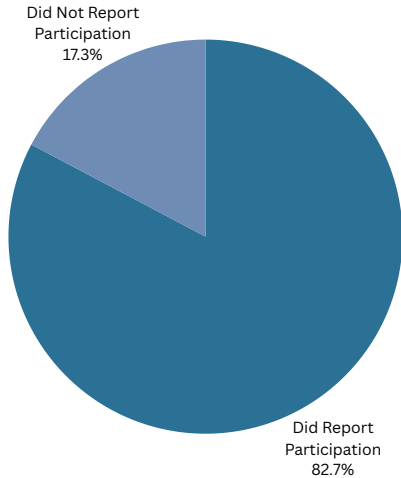

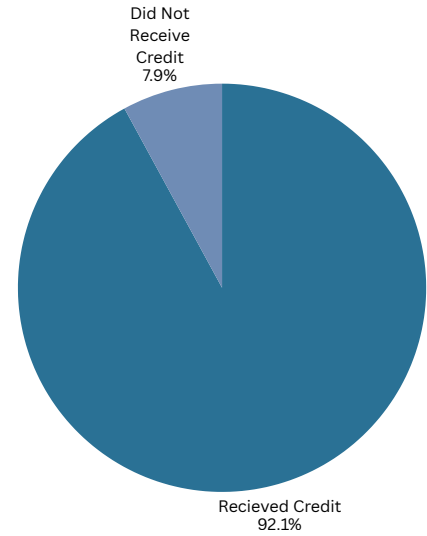
Internships & Practical Experience

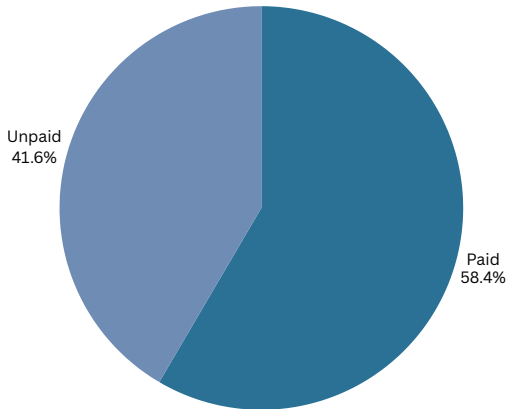
Students Who Reported Participation In Internships/Practical Experience Prior to Graduation



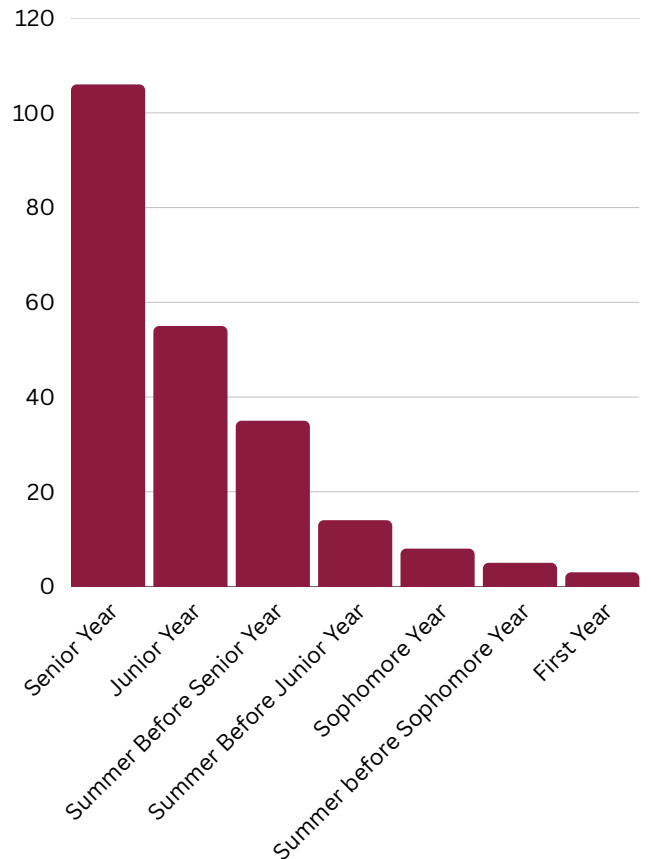
Students Who Received Academic Credit at EU for their Internships/ Practical Experiences



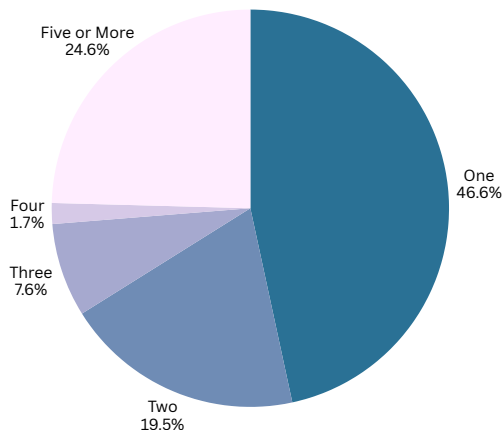
Paid vs. Unpaid Student Internships/Practical Experiences
