Mission Statement: Warner Memorial Library

The mission of Eastern University Libraries is to provide information access and research instruction to all of Eastern University's communities; making a difference in the world, church, and individuals through Christian higher education.

Warner Memorial Library serves all academic constituencies with the provision of organized collections of books and media, online resources, reference, and research instruction. The Austen K. deBlois Library of Palmer Theological Seminary serves Eastern University by providing theological resources and services to the seminary, graduate, undergraduate, and alumni communities of Eastern University.

Eastern University Libraries adhere to the Characteristics of Excellence applicable to libraries from the Middle States Association on Higher Education; and the standards of the Association of Colleges and Research Libraries. The Austen K. deBlois Library also conforms to standards of the Association of Theological Schools. We assess our service through regular surveys of faculty and students. [Rev 12-1-2014]

Executive Summary

Warner Memorial Library at St. Davids and the Austen K. deBlois Library of the Seminary continue to work toward providing collections, databases, and instruction for our academic community and its stakeholders. This coming year we will develop our library self-concept and motto of becoming a "A Teaching Library." Some ways we do this is through communication with our electronic Newsletter the Bibliofile, with the Warner Memorial Library Facebook (<https://www.facebook.com/wmlib>), with our Twitter account (<https://twitter.com/warnerlib>); and with our Blog (<https://warnerlibeu.wordpress.com/>). We teach through reference, library instruction in classroom, reference consultations, webinars, and our self-produced videos and tutorials. Coupled with traditional services and instruction, we also add value to the cultural life of the University. We sponsor academic contests like the Friends of the Library Jonathan Orr Essay, and students events like donut night depicted on the front page of this Annual Report. We sponsor concerts like the Travis Wetzal Trio. We host University events and Agora Institute events. We extend our help overseas by giving books to African libraries, like *the Olivia S. Washington School of Liberia*. Our University mission is faith reason and justice with the whole gospel, for the whole world, through whole people.

Library Summary Statement of Collections and Services

[This statement is maintained for Eastern's Department of Institutional Research as a summary of library operations]

Warner Memorial Library, the central library of Eastern University, houses over 270,396 volumes (ACRL Formula), including 300 print periodical subscriptions, over 869,487 microforms, and a collection of 17,421 DVDs, video and audio recordings. Database subscriptions connect to more than 66,000 online periodicals. Students also have access to special collections of books donated to the University. These include the Vodges collection on Marcus Aurelius, and Harry S. Goebel's collection of books on fine printing, bookplates, illustrated books, and book collecting. Additional libraries throughout the region are accessible through the 43 member Tri-state College Library Cooperative. Books from other libraries are available using Inter-Library Loans. Over 55 million volumes are available through the OCLC catalogue. The library is also a member of PALCI, the Pennsylvania Academic Library Consortium, Inc., and has over 36,000,000 books available within 2-3 days through direct EZ Borrow Inter-library loan system. Access PA allows interlibrary loan to Pennsylvania libraries. The library has online full text periodical database vendors like Ebscohost, which contains 36 separate databases, JSTOR, Lexis-Nexis, Sage and Proquest. Other full text online tools like Encyclopedia Britannica, Facts.com, Newsbank, and "Annual Reviews" offer current scholarly information. Besides the print collection, access is available to a collection of more than 170,000 online books through eBrary, Ebscohost's ebook collection, ATLA theological ebooks, Psycbooks and the reference database, Credo. Refworks, a citation manager, is available for all students. The library maintains a Facebook account, and communicates through Twitter as well as a Blog. Libguides are provided on our homepage to direct research by academic area. The library uses TLC, an automated library catalogue system, and maintains forty computer workstations. The Catalog and all databases are available to students on and off campus using the EZ Proxy interface. The Mazie Hall room maintains a collection of African American books. On August 7, 2005, the Harold C. Howard Center, a 20,800 square foot addition to the library was completed which doubled the building's physical size, adding shelf space, study rooms, study tables, compact shelving, a media room and a net increase of 3 classrooms and a seminar room. All of the classrooms are equipped with a permanent data video projector, VCR, DVD and instructor computer with a touch screen control panel. Secure, authenticated wireless network access was installed throughout the entire building during the summer of 2005. The University bookstore was expanded and moved into the lower level of the addition with a separate outside entrance.

Palmer Theological Seminary's Austen K. deBlois Library cooperates as a sister library in the Eastern University system. The collection of the seminary library numbers 79,672 items, primarily in theology and Biblical studies. Students from each of the University's schools have access to the library services, collections, and databases of both the Warner and deBlois libraries. Palmer students also have user borrowing privileges at 19 libraries in SEPTLA, the Southeast Pennsylvania Theological Library Association network. [April 2014]

Faculty Handbook Statement on Libraries

7.26 Libraries

1. Eastern University Libraries exist to serve our faculty and students. We also serve the local residents, library networks, cooperatives, and the greater Christian academic community. The services and policies of our main libraries—Warner Memorial Library at St. Davids and Palmer Theological Seminary’s Austen K. DeBlois library are found on our website. The library coordinates with two other University libraries: The Helen Craymer Curriculum Lab in McInnis Hall and the Esperanza College Library in Philadelphia. Falls Center maintains an unstaffed storage collection. All materials are accessible on request or on site with an Eastern University ID.
2. The cooperatives we support are PALCI (the Pennsylvania Academic Library Consortium Inc); and TCLC (the Tri-state College Library Cooperative). The Seminary is a member of SEPTLA (Southeast Pennsylvania Theological Library Association). A faculty Eastern University ID and a library letter are needed to use any cooperating library. Libraries in cooperation are listed on the Library homepage. Interlibrary Loan request links are found for both books and articles.
3. The Library provides library instruction in person and through online tutorials. The library creates research libguides to provide links to subject areas and topics. The faculty are responsible to work with the library in providing academic suggestions for the improvement of library instruction, online tutorials, and libguides.
4. Faculty are responsible to recommend material purchases for the library collection; provide materials for reserve for course readings; and to suggest the removal of outdated materials from the collection. They should develop course syllabi based on what resources are available to fulfill assignments to students.
5. The Director of University and Seminary Libraries is responsible for planning, policies, and collection and resource development within the budgetary constraints of the institution. [December 2013]

Comment

Circulation of the Seminary Library has dropped significantly since the move in 2012. There are multiple reasons for this. When at Wynnewood, we had a resident community that had immediate use of the collection; and this included the use of children's books for families. Currently, the warehousing of the main Palmer library, and the cumbersome difficulty of getting materials, have reduced circulation. Another factor is the reduction of the total number of students.
