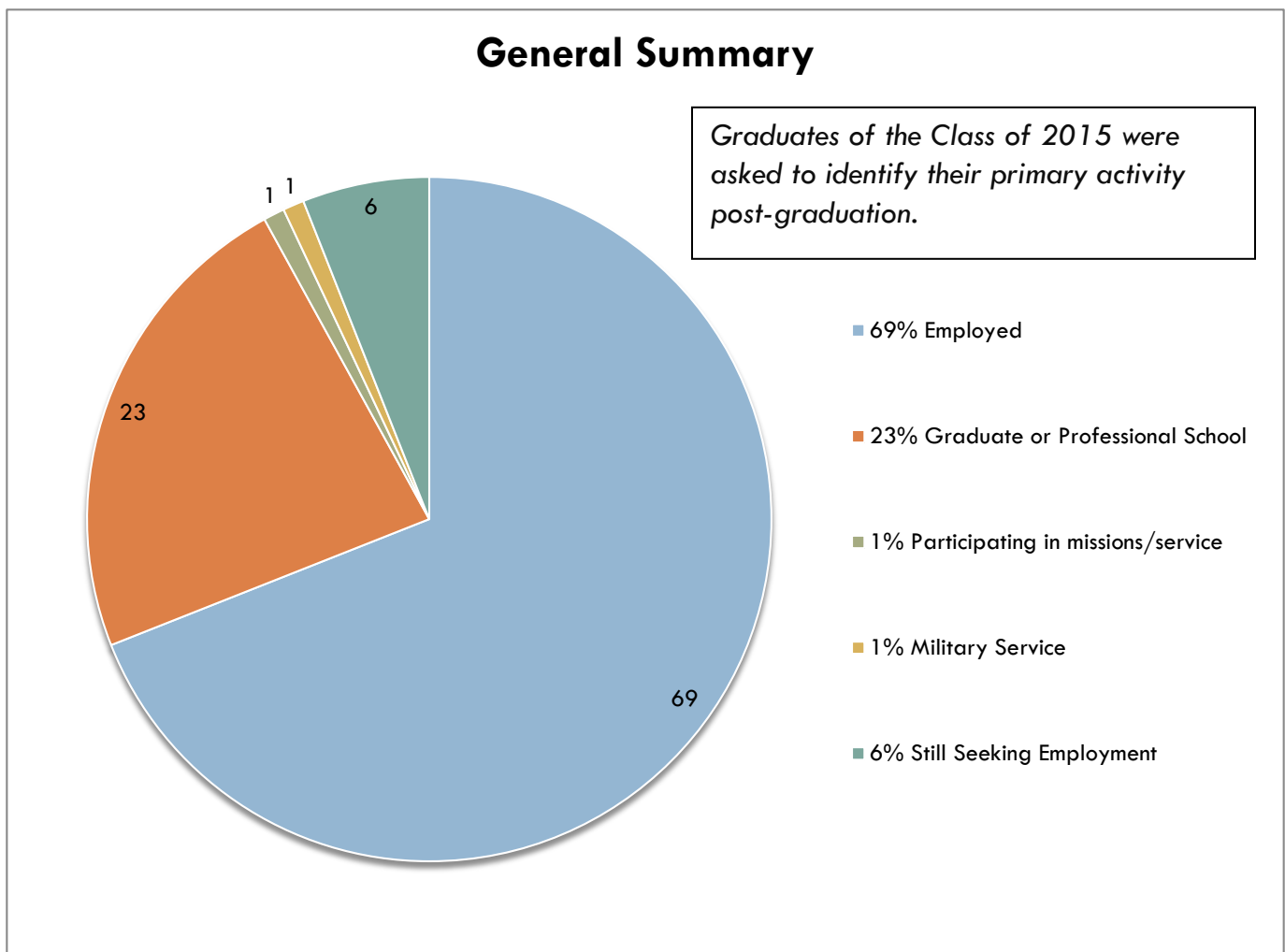

FROM THE SURVEY OF THE MOST RECENT TRADITIONAL BACCALAUREATE COLLEGES' GRADUATING CLASSES, A TOTAL OF **94%** OF THE RESPONDENTS ARE EMPLOYED, INVOLVED IN POST-GRADUATE EDUCATION, SERVING IN FULL TIME VOLUNTEER WORK, OR SERVING IN THE MILITARY WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF GRADUATION. *



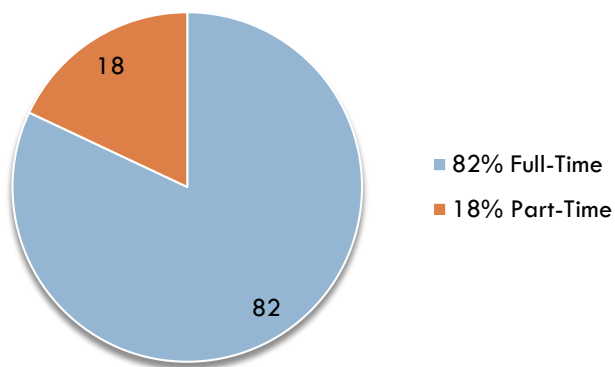
***40% of the Class of 2015 participated in this survey (136 of 341 graduates).**

EMPLOYMENT

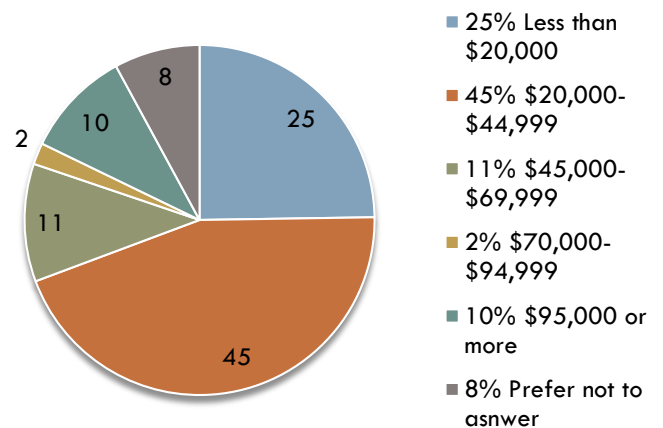
69% of the Class of 2015 survey respondents reported employment as their primary activity following graduation. 82% of those employed are working in full-time positions.

91% of employed graduates indicate their current job is related or somewhat related to their major. 88% of employed graduates are very satisfied or satisfied with their current employment.

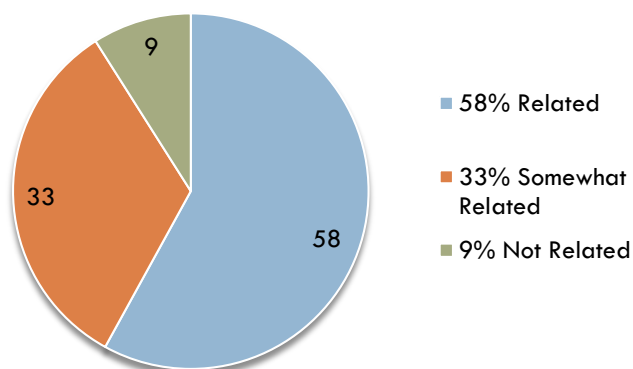
Type of Employment



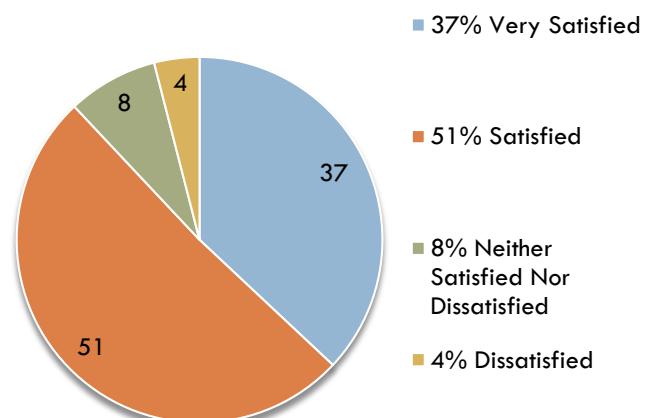
Salary

Satisfaction with Current Employment

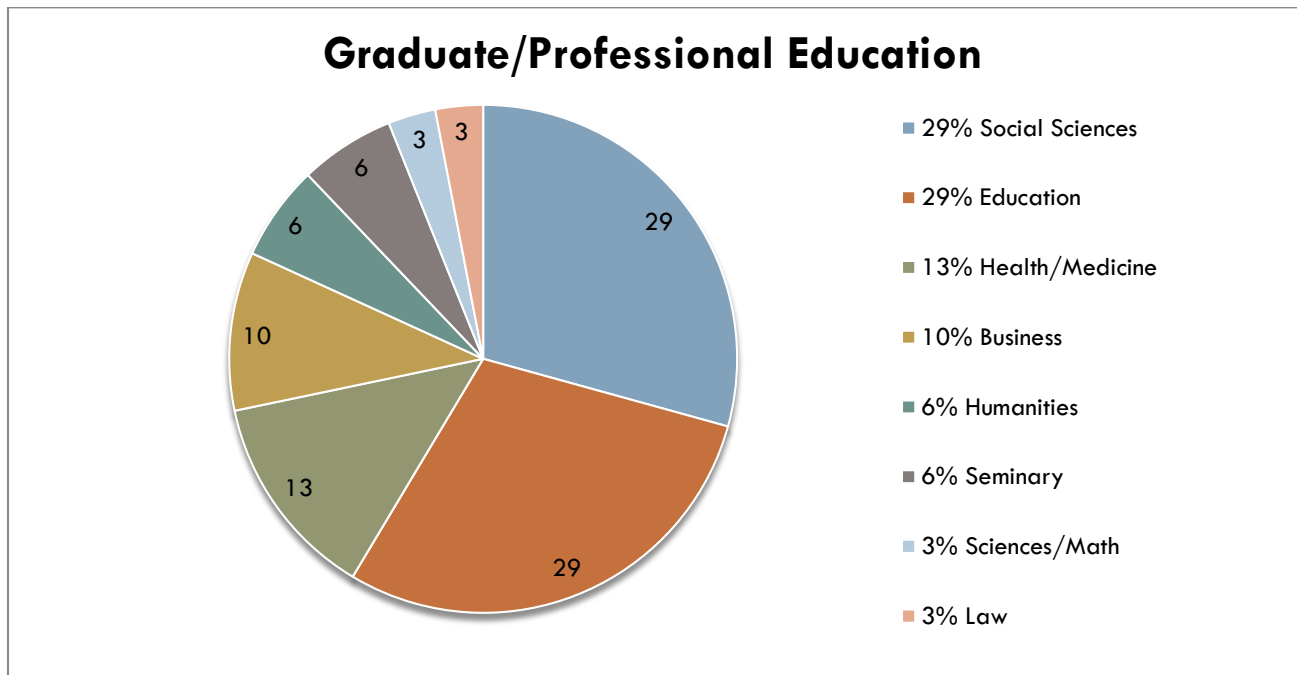

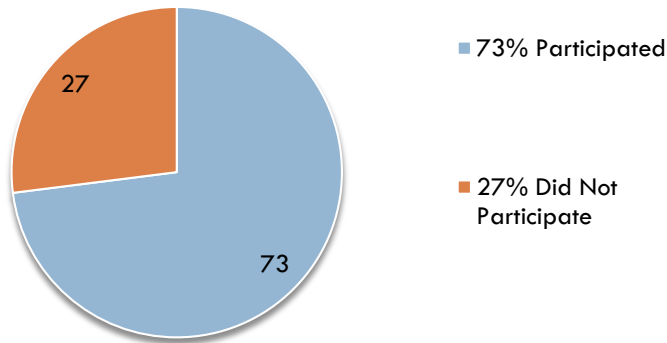

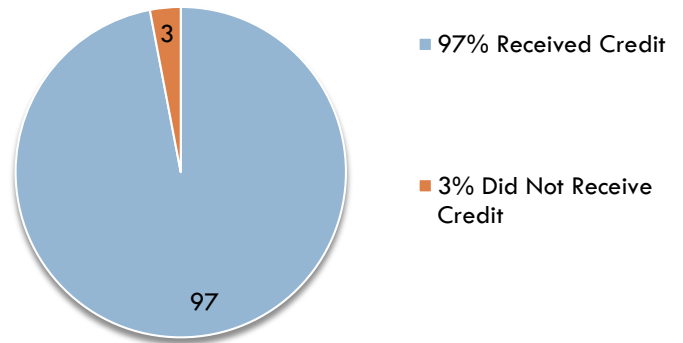
INTERNSHIPS & PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

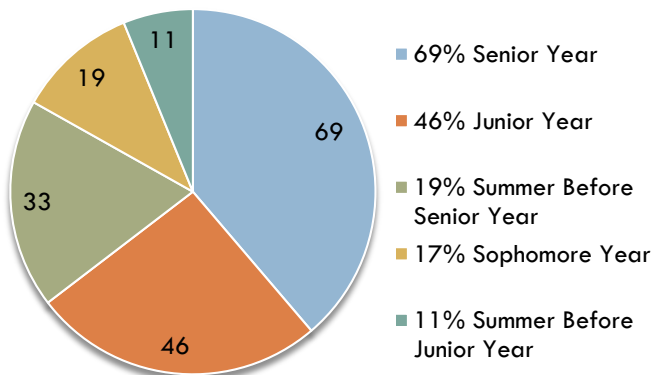
Students Who Participated In Internships/Practical Experience Prior to Graduation



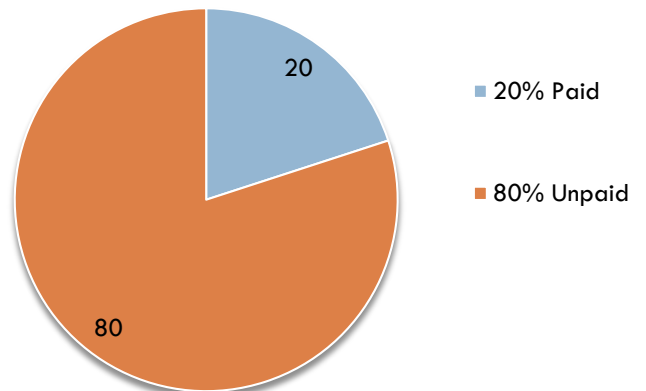
Students Who Received Academic Credit at EU for their Internships/ Practical Experiences

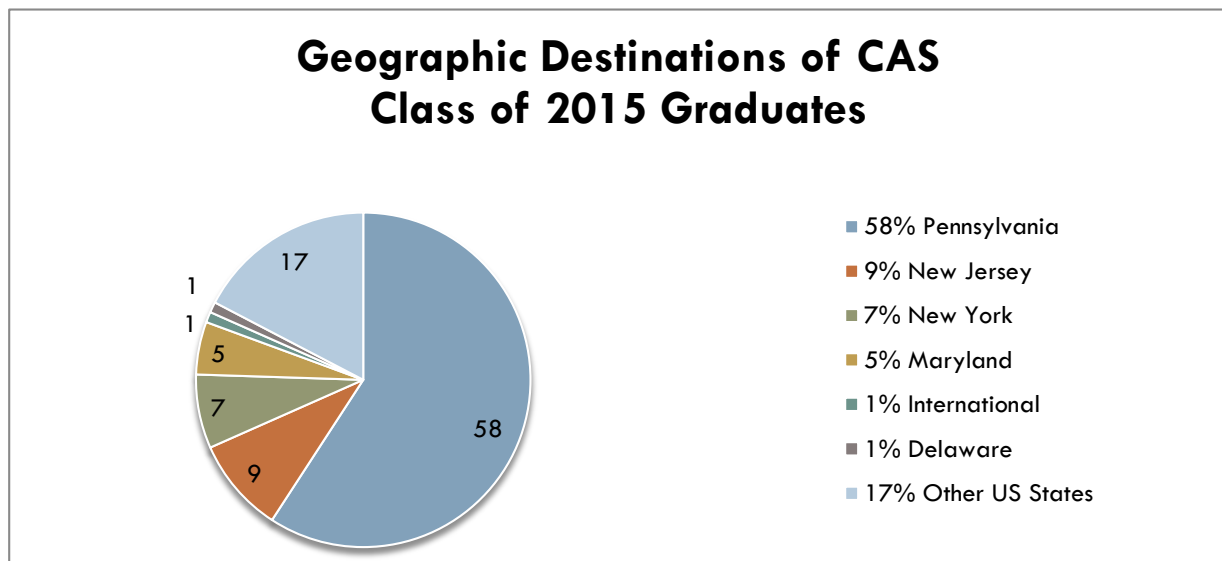

“I wouldn't have had my internship and now my job without **Talent and Career Development!**”

“**I work at a top law firm's DC office** (their headquarters are in NY) in recruiting and professional development. I'm involved in lateral recruiting, the firm's DC summer associate program, law school recruiting, and helping current Paul Weiss' associates, counsel and partners continue their legal education.”

“I am learning skills necessary to start a nonprofit, getting hands on leadership experience, and creating a donor base for **future ministry in the Dominican Republic.**”

“I am currently working for a company that is growing extremely rapidly. I aid in clinical research by analyzing the data collected at the sites

during the study. I absolutely love my job...**I am so thankful for my experiences at Eastern and how they have brought me to where I am in life.**”

“I am working as analytical chemist for cosmetics company. It is going very well; **I was well prepared for my career as a chemist.**”

“**I got a job offer before I graduated,** and started two days after graduation. I work in production, which was my goal. I am part of an exciting developing field, producing live internet broadcasts of webinars that cater to those seeking professional education.”

“**I love my job!** I have been working at My Gym, a children's fitness center, since September. In the beginning of February I was promoted to director of the gym, where I teach and oversee staff.”

“I am the Graduate Peer Mentor at Eastern for the CSP, and doing the **MA in Counseling with a Trauma Studies concentration.** I am still volunteering with Church of the Savior youth group, where I interned my senior year.”

53% of CAS 2015 graduates sought individual career counseling from Eastern University's Talent and Career Development during their senior year at Eastern.

99% of CAS 2015 graduates who sought individual career counseling from Talent and Career Development were satisfied or very satisfied with the services they received.

“I am studying for my Master's of Social Service at Bryn Mawr in the Advanced Standing program. I am in a field placement for my MSS degree and am with the Salvation Army again in a different capacity, **working with survivors** of domestic minor sex trafficking.”

“I currently am working within HR at a software company in Exton. I worked as an intern here for a full calendar year before I was hired full-time. I have great impact with this organization and work directly with the AVP of Global HR. **I have a clear career development path.**”

“I started working for a local tree company at the end of May. I love climbing and doing tree work, so it is the perfect fit for me. Although some people may think it is not related, **I believe my youth ministry experience at Eastern has prepared me to be a great team leader in my field...**I have the best job in the world, I get to climb trees and do ministry at the same time.”

“I'm doing well! I am far from home, so I miss my friends and family, but I am very satisfied with my first job out of college. I'm teaching 5th Math, 5th Language Arts, 7th Life Science, and 8th Earth Science at a classical Christian school in Jackson, WY. While I did not earn a degree in education while at Eastern, **my academic and extracurricular activities during college prepared me well for this job.**”

“I started as an auditor in public accounting right out of college and **my internship experiences played a key role** in getting an offer for this job. I really love it!”

“I am currently in my "gap year" before **I begin medical school in the Fall.** I am working part time as a math tutor and with my other free time I volunteer at hospitals to gain experience for med school and am a volunteer leader for Wyldlife (YoungLife for middle schoolers).”

“I am employed as a Transitional Living Assistant at the Milton Hershey School. I am a live-in mentor for high school seniors who are transitioning to either college, the military or the workplace. I love my position. **I get to have a very holistic, hands-on teaching experience** and I get to share my background with my students and help them on their way to graduation and beyond.”

“Teaching at a classical school that hires college grads with humanities backgrounds, not teaching backgrounds. I had to move to AZ for the opportunity, **but I couldn't have picked a better school.**”

“I am currently doing a one year program at Boston College to earn my MSW. My concentration is in mental health. I am currently interning at a residential program for people transitioning out of the state hospital and I provide individual and group therapy... **I am so thankful for all Eastern taught me.**”

“A week after graduating from Eastern I started working as a part-time writer for the **official website of Minor League baseball in New York City**...I absolutely love what I'm doing. I'm excited to hopefully use this as a stepping stone to a job reporting on baseball on a full-time basis in the future, something that has been a dream of mine for a long time. I'm so thankful to everyone in the Eastern career offices and in the journalism program for helping me to get where I am!”

“I am in graduate school for counseling and it is going SO well. The **Psychology program at Eastern is amazing** and prepared me so well for graduate school and my internship in undergrad at Dine Monte Nido helped show me what I wanted to be doing with my life and what population I want to work with.”

“**My time at Eastern was instrumental in how I perform within the working world today.** My professors and classroom experiences have molded not only my ethical views on business but also have strengthened how I relate to my co-workers. College was a long road for me. I went to three different institutions and eventually ended up at Eastern. It was the greatest decision I made. I get to on a daily basis be in a position where my studies and experiences through college help mold who I am as a working adult.”

“I graduated in May and started working in June with Holy Redeemer. I work as a social worker on a rehab floor primarily serving older adults. It is a very fast-paced job, but I am learning a lot. I know for a fact the biggest reason I got hired for this job was my internship experience through the Social Work Program's Practicum. **My real world experience and practical skills were what impressed my employer and gave me the ability to secure my current position.**”

“I love working at an international school in Germany! Although I am not teaching in a literal classroom I know that my degree in education along with my experiences and other classes at **EU prepared me for this role** as a caretaker for 20 high school boarding students.”

“Working with kids in the field of psychology. My education has helped me immensely. **I use what I've learned every day on the job.** I'm constantly recalling helpful information from my former classes at Eastern.”

“**I am currently launching/leading a new piece of technology** called a "BioLounge" which serves as a therapeutic session utilizing Biofeedback therapy, sound and massage therapy, and guided imagery. I work with a large range of clientele from addiction, eating disorder, general anxiety, trauma, etc. “

“Without my experience in the Eastern social work department I would not have been remotely prepared for this position. I work with teenagers from 13 to 18 years of age who struggle with depression, anxiety, anger, substance abuse, ADD, ADHD, Oppositional Defiance Disorder, etc. I live with these girls and help them learn basic life skills including receiving consequences for poor choices. It is a hard and yet fulfilling job because I am in a unique position to show them God's love.”

“My level of satisfaction and fulfillment in my current job I fully accredit to my time and education at the Templeton Honors College. I would not have attended Eastern if it were not for the THC's curriculum, dedication to excellence, and fantastic professors.”

“I am currently working as a social worker at a clinic that serves a large population of individuals. I am learning a lot and putting into practice what Eastern taught me through the books. It's exciting to see how God reveals himself in my work and **the blessing it is to be able to integrate EU's core values reason, faith, and justice.**”

“I'm currently working at a juvenile detention center and am in the process of **transitioning into a supervisor.**”

“I am currently a school social worker. I am working with students in grades K through 12th. I am **enjoying my job to the fullest.** I am placed where I wanted to be as a social worker.”
